

How many DE courses can a student take?

DE courses may be taken for a combined total of no more than 27 credit hours without incurring additional fees of \$50 per credit hour. This additional fee is applied because the state of Texas will not pay a state subsidy for any DE credit hours in excess of 27 credit hours. In addition, students may attempt to successfully complete any DE course only twice before incurring additional fees. Dropping a course before census day does not count as an attempt. After two unsuccessful attempts, students must pay an additional \$50 per credit hour (i.e., for a three hour course, additional fees are calculated as $3 \times \$50 = \150 additional tuition). Or the student may complete the course at another institution and provide proof of successful course completion upon returning to Collin College.
