Course Description: A continuation of the fundamentals of equipment used in oxyacetylene and Shielded Metal Arc Welding (SMAW), including welding and cutting safety, basic oxyacetylene welding and cutting, basic SMAW processes and basic metallurgy. This course covers the theory and introduction to the shielded metal arc welding (SMAW) processes. Skill in the welding process and the selection of materials and equipment will be stressed.

Suggested Course Prerequisite(s): Completion of WLDG 1015 - Welding I or Basic experience in GMAQ, GTAW and SMAW as well as oxyfuel, and plasma cutting experience.
