Careers in dance extend beyond the familiar roles of performing, choreographing, and teaching. Are you also interested in business? Consider owning a dance studio or pursuing a graduate degree in arts administration to prepare you to work for a professional company and oversee outreach and funding. Do you love to write? Make a career out of dance writing by becoming a dance critic who travels to performances and composes reviews for newspapers and websites. Are you interested in history? Devote yourself to the study of historical trends, issues, and topics in dance, and work to become a dance historian. Do you watch Project Runway and dream of being a designer? Consider becoming a dance costume designer. Do you have a keen eye for observing movement and extracting meaning? Continue your studies in dance by enrolling in a Certified Movement Analyst (C.M.A.) program.

Enroll in Dance Appreciation (DANC 2303) to get a grasp of the scope of the dance world and the many careers it entails. Dance Appreciation satisfies part of the core curriculum and is offered on all three campuses and online. Marc Chagall, Chagall: Beyond Color


Elledanceworks explores Chagall's world of color and imagery through choreography and improvisation.
