This year's Collin Dance Ensemble is an intimate group of eight dancers. The Artistic Director, Tiffanee Arnold, selected a smaller number of dedicated dancers so that each dancer could receive more individual feedback and instruction this year. In addition, these dancers had the opportunity to work closely with each of the full time dance professors. Lesley Snelson and Meghan Cardwell-Wilson re-staged works from their personal repertoires on the company in the fall, and Courtney Mulcahy will set a work on CDE this semester.

In March CDE will travel to the American College Dance Association South Central Conference. This year's conference will be held at Texas Tech University in Lubbock, Texas. CDE dancer and department student assistant, Natalie Trollinger, has been selected to present her choreography for adjudication by a panel of nationally recognized dance artists. Natalie says, "I am honored to represent our dance department. I went to last year's conference and learned a lot. I am most excited to see my work onstage and hear comments about it."

In addition to Lubbock, CDE will travel to Normal, Illinois for a dance exchange with Illinois State University. Other opportunities this semester include performing at the First United Methodist Church of Plano and learning choreography by Elledanceworks company member, Delanie Biter. CDE will also perform at the Fusion Dance Company Benefit Concert in February and at the Plano Dance Festival in April.
