Passing the reading and writing portion is required to maintain F-1 status at Collin College and avoid a Change of Level to Collin's ESL program or transferring to another institution. Review TSI testing procedures, locations, study materials, and exemptions below. It is recommended that you take the TSI before your arrival.
