

TEXAS ALL-STAR JAZZ CAMP RULES AND REGULATIONS

CAMP POLICY

The camp reserves the right, upon notification of parent or guardian, to dismiss any student during the camp for the infraction of the following rules and regulations. This decision will be made in the best judgment of administration and counseling staff, and when the behavior of the student is detrimental to other students or the normal activities of the Texas All-Star Jazz Camp. Following the notification of the parent or guardian, they will need to arrange and provide immediate transportation home for their son or daughter at their own expense. There will be no refund of fees.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The Texas All-Star Jazz Camp and Collin County Community College District (Collin) accept no responsibility for the theft, loss, or breakage of personal items, money, or valuables.
- Attendance at daily rehearsals, master classes, theory classes, and sectionals is required. Attendance will be monitored each day.
- Students are required to stay in the area of the college where the Texas All –Star Jazz Camp takes place. College facilities such as racquetball courts, weight-lifting rooms etc., are not for camp participants usage. Students are also not allowed in restricted areas of the college such as the catwalks above the stage, the actor’s balconies, storage facilities etc. A good general rule is, “If you are not sure, don’t go there”.
- Students are not allowed to ride in an unauthorized vehicle while attending the Texas All-Star Jazz Camp. This includes the car of a Collin student or employee, faculty or participants of the Texas All-Star Jazz Camp, or other authorized guest on the Collin campus. An

authorized vehicle only includes your personal car or that of a family member.

- The possession or consumption of any type of alcohol or controlled substance is absolutely prohibited. If a student is found to have in his/her possession any type of alcohol or drugs, or is found consuming alcohol or drugs, they will be dismissed immediately.
- Collin College is a smoke free environment. This includes all Collin property both indoors and outdoors.
