



- Pg. 8 High School Information, use the search bar to find your high school, once selected it will show up where it says "your school"
  - Home school students, can search "Home Schooled" and then enter in location information for your home
  - Enter your approximate Graduate Date ex. 05/25/2024, 05/25/2025, 05/25/2026, 05/25/2027
  - If your school does not appear in the list use the "School not found" option and enter your school name and location.
  - GED: will always be "no" while you are a dual credit student


#### **PROFILE TIPS:**





#### APPLICATION – HEALTH SCIENCES/CTE


- If you are taking any core classes in addition to health sciences/CTE, follow the application instructions on the prior slide.






#### Perkins Eligibility \*

Perkins funding is provided to support our workforce programs and the students that attend them. Your responses help Collin College to identify funding needs.


