Your CougarWeb login information will be emailed to your personal email once accepted. Be sure to check your spam folder. Tip: use your non-ISD email to apply, ISD emails block outside emails.

	Completed in CougarWeb on the Student Tab. If needed, please call 972.881.5902 for assistance.							
<u>Se</u>	t up OneLogin (New Students)							
	Once you complete your Campus Safety Training, you will receive your OneLogin credentials giving you access to your Collin College email address. Tip: Set up OneLogin on a device that you will have access to at all times.
