

BE IT RESOLVED, at the recommendation of the President, that the Board of Trustees of Collin County Community College District approves the 2011 Calculated Effective Tax Rate and Rollback Rate.

## 2011 Property Tax Rates in Collin County Community College District

This notice concerns the 2011 property tax rates for Collin County Community College District. It presents information about three tax rates. Last year's tax rate is the actual tax rate the taxing unit used to determine property taxes last year. This year's *effective* tax rate would impose the same total taxes as last year if you compare properties taxed in both years. This year's *rollback* tax rate is the highest tax rate the taxing unit can set before taxpayers start rollback procedures. In each case these rates are found by dividing the total amount of taxes by the tax base (the total value of taxable property) with adjustments as required by state law. The rates are given per \$100 of property value.

### Last year's tax rate:

### This year's rollback tax rate:

Last year's adjusted operating taxes (after subtracting taxes on lost property and adjusting for any transferred function, tax increment financing, state criminal justice mandate, and/or enhanced indigent healthcare expenditures)	\$54,029,241
+ This year's adjusted tax base	\$67,248,150,112
= This year's effective operating rate	\$0.080343/\$100
x 1.08 = this year's maximum operating rate	\$0.086770/\$100
+ This year's debt rate	\$0.006300/\$100
= This year's total rollback rate	\$0.093070/\$100

### Statement of Increase/Decrease

If Collin County Community College District adopts a 2011 tax rate equal to the effective tax rate of \$0.086670 per \$100 of value, taxes would decrease compared to 2010 taxes by \$-139,483.

### Schedule A - Unencumbered Fund Balance

The following estimated balances will be left in the unit's property tax accounts at the end of the fiscal year. These balances are not encumbered by a corresponding debt obligation.
