

Fire Inspector I & II Plans Examiner

The Fire Inspector course will prepare students to perform fire inspections with the purpose of limiting the risk of life and property loss by recognizing fire and safety hazards early. The students will be able to perform detailed fire inspections and recommend corrective actions. Upon successful completion of this course, students will take the state certification exam for Basic Fire Inspector I & Inspector II. This is a blended on-line/classroom course which meets for two (2) classroom sessions every other week. Plans Examiner includes (6) classroom days, course final, skill, & state exam.
