 - Pay your visa fee
 - Obtain acceptable photographs
 - Complete your online DS-160 application
 - Get list of all required documents you must bring
 - Schedule your visa interview appointment
- If you are not granted the F-1 Visa, please contact ISO at iso@collin.edu about your deferment options.

STUDY FOR TEXAS SUCCESS INITIATIVE (TSI) OR PREPARE TSI EXEMPTION

- When you arrive in the U.S., you will be required to take the Texas Success Initiative (TSI), provide TSI scores from a previous school, OR request an exemption with qualifying documentation with Academic Advising (academicadvising@collin.edu) before registering for classes.
- Passing the reading and writing portion is required to maintain F-1 status at Collin College and avoid transferring to another institution or Change of Level to Collin's ESL program.

PREPARE FOR ARRIVAL

- Recommended Arrival date: **05/20/2019**. Allowed to arrive in U.S. up to 30 days before start of I-20.
