**Student Handbook** The District President or designee shall develop student hand-

books with information on rights, responsibilities, services, resources, extracurricular activities, and other information required by policy or that students need to be successful during the academic year. The District President or designee shall ensure that no student handbook information is in conflict with policy. In case of conflict between a Board policy and provisions of student hand-

books, policy shall prevail.
