



- We received approval from the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC) to offer an associate of applied science degree and level 1 and level 2 certificates in construction management
- Coursework will be offered this fall to build toward the associate degree and certificate programs
- Initially offered at the Frisco campus, the program **will move** to the new **Collin College Technical Campus in 2020**
