1. Collin College's hospitality program was selected for new scholarship program

- The Institute of Hospitality and Culinary Education at Collin College is one
 of 10, two-year hospitality programs in the country selected to partner in
 a new scholarship program with the American Hotel & Lodging Foundation
 (AHLA Foundation).
- The new endeavor will provide \$100,000 to students signing up for the 2021-2022 academic year.
- The newly created two-year scholarship program will provide meaningful support to deserving hospitality students, particularly those who may not otherwise have access to a higher education.
- These scholarships will cover a substantial portion of students' tuition and school costs for a year.





2. Craig Leverette announced as new Campus Provost of the Frisco Campus

- Collin College has appointed Craig Leverette as the new campus provost of the Frisco Campus (Preston Ridge).
- Leverette has served Collin College in a number of roles for 24 years.
- Prior to being named a campus provost, he was the dean of academic affairs and workforce at the Wylie Campus.
- Leverette began his career at Collin College in 1997 as the head softball coach and a physical education professor at the Frisco Campus. He went on to serve as a department chair, associate dean, and dean at two campuses.
- Leverette, an Allen resident, is in the final year of completing his doctoral degree from Texas A&M University-Commerce.

3. Collin College holds ribbon cutting ceremony for Wylie Campus

- Collin College held a ribbon cutting on Sept. 25 to celebrate the opening of the new Wylie Campus.
- While fall classes began Aug. 24 at the new campus, the Friday night ribbon cutting event marked the official opening celebration of the Wylie Campus.
- The event was attended by officials from Collin College, local government, and Wylie ISD as well as local partners.
- Located at 391 Country Club Road in Wylie, the tree-lined campus boasts three large buildings: the student center with an attached conference center, the campus commons, and the library.
