### 1. Two Collin College Basketball Players Named All-Americans


 Collin College's Waiata Jennings and Mackenzie Buss have been honored as National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) Division I Women's Basketball All-Americans.



- Both players were part of Collin College's first basketball team to play in an NJCAA national tournament.
- The 2022-2023 **Collin College Lady Cougars** recorded an overall record of **29-3**, setting a school record for most wins and finishing the regular season at **No. 7** in the **NJCAA coaches poll**.
- The team also earned the college's first-ever at-large invitation to the NJCAA National Basketball Tournament.

#### 2. Collin College Theatre Department Presents "The Fantasticks"

- Join the Collin College Theatre Department for "**The Fantasticks**," a musical tale of a boy, a girl, a scoundrel, and two scheming but well-meaning fathers, **Wednesday-Sunday**, **May 3-7** in the **Black Box Theatre at the Plano Campus**.
- This classic musical of love, romance, adventure, family, and discovering what life can really be about has been lauded for its nostalgic and universal themes. With music by Harvey Schmidt and book and lyrics by Tom Jones, the show ran off-Broadway for 42 years, making it the world's longest-running musical.
- The Collin College Theatre Department production is directed by **Joanne Zipay**, who founded and served as artistic director of New York City's Judith Shakespeare Company for 20 years, from 1995-2015.
- Performances begin at 7:30 p.m., May 3-6 Matinee shows begin at 2:30 p.m., May 6 and 7. Tickets are free for students, \$5 for veterans, the military, and those ages 65 or older, and \$10 per person for all others.



## 3. Collin College Offers Summer 2023 Tuition and Fee Credit Program

- This summer, Collin College is offering up to **six hours** in tuition and fee credits to qualifying students who enroll by **noon on May 3**.
- Individuals living in the college's service area who are **Spring 2023** high school graduates are eligible to apply for the tuition and fee credit program.
