



# TSI ASSESSMENT ACCOMMODATION REQUEST

## What is the TSI (Texas Success Initiative)?

The TSI is an untimed state wide college level entry exam designed to determine if a student is ready for college-level course work in the general areas of reading, writing and mathematics.

Due to recent campus closures because of COVID-19, the TSI is now offered remotely. If you need TSI accommodations, please follow the steps listed below.

**Step 1:** Complete your Collin application and receive your CWID number through email from Admissions.

**Step 2:** Email [ACCESS@collin.edu](mailto:ACCESS@collin.edu) with the following information for accommodation approval: requested accommodation(s) and supporting documentation of a disability. Please allow **two weeks** for review and processing. For the Documentation Guidelines/Eligibility form, please visit

**Step 3:** Complete the [Pre-Assessment Activity \(PAA\)](#).

**Step 4:** Submit request for test scheduling [here](#). Please allow **5-7 business days** for your request to be processed.

**Step 5:** A voucher will be sent to your Collin email with instructions for the day of testing.

**Step 6:** Upon completion of your TSI Assessment, your scores will automatically upload to your Collin College account within 1 hour. This will remove your TSI hold and allow for registration, if all other holds have been resolved.
