	Texas Hazlewood Act Exemption Application – Initial Application
	O Signed IN INK and dated by BOTH the veteran and the student
	<u>DD214 – Member 2 or 4 copy</u> – Full copy must be submitted.
	o Home of Record or Place of Entry must show Texas.
	o Discharge must be (Honorable/General).
	O Veteran must have also served at least 181 days, excluding training.
	Veteran may also be eligible if they were a Texas resident at time of entry
	o A DD Form 214 may be obtained from the National Archives: <u>DD 214 Online</u> <u>Is student a Chapter 33?</u> YES NO
	o If Yes, Student must submit a copy of the VA Certificate of Eligibility Access COE Online
	o Chapter 33 can only be used with Hazlewood if CH 33 percentage is less than 100%.
	Student enrolled in classes? YES NO
	ONLY Chapter 33/Post 9/11 students MUST be enrolled in order to post exemption.
	<u>Veteran's Residency</u> – MUST be in Texas UNLESS they or their spouse have military orders placing them outside Texas.
	Student's Residency – MUST be either in-county or out-of-county.
	<u>Proof of Relationship to Veteran</u> – To show the relationship to the veteran
	o Child – Submit a copy of the birth certificate (Step-child also include the marriage certificate)
	o Spouse, Adopted Child, Tax Dependent – Submit a copy of tax documents or other legal
	document showing proof of relationship.

	o <u>Student</u> will need to create an account and print out their hours.
	o <u>Veteran</u> will need to create an account and print out their hours.
