**Therapist.** The role respiratory therapists play in critical care can be fastpaced, challenging and personally rewarding. They are responsible for airway care, ventilator management, and patient monitoring, working with a team to keep their patients breathing. RTs also provide general care through oxygen therapy, volume augmentation, and other treatments. Respiratory Therapists work in emergency departments, intensive care areas, neonatal and pediatric units, operating rooms, skilled nursing facilities, asthma education and smoking cessation programs, and even in the transport of critically ill patients.

The college's competitive admission 22-month program prepares students to apply for the Therapist Multiple-Choice and Clinical Simulation credentialing exams given by the National Board for Respiratory Care.
