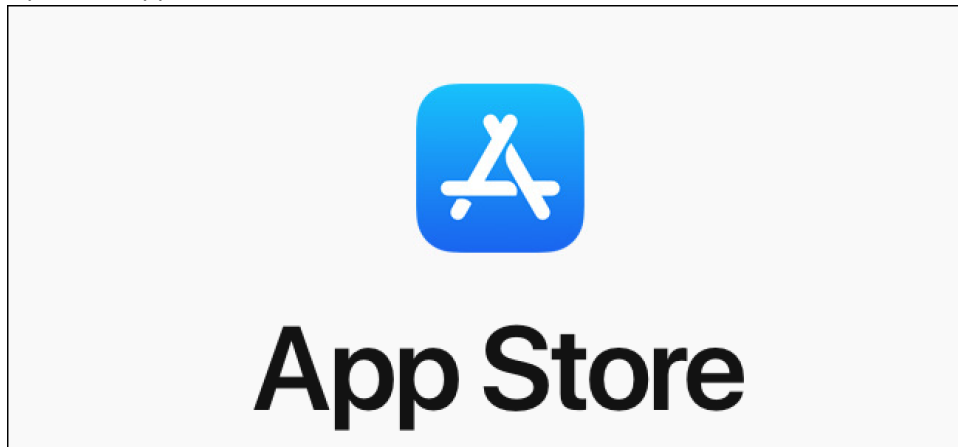


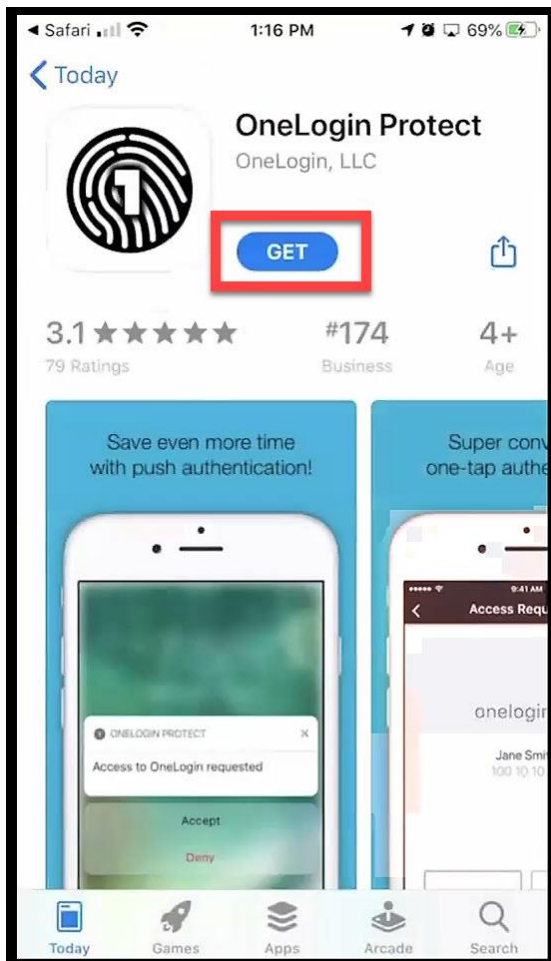
OneLogin Setup Instructions using Iphone

2 Requirements: IOS 9 or later and a device Passcode setup (see Step #10)

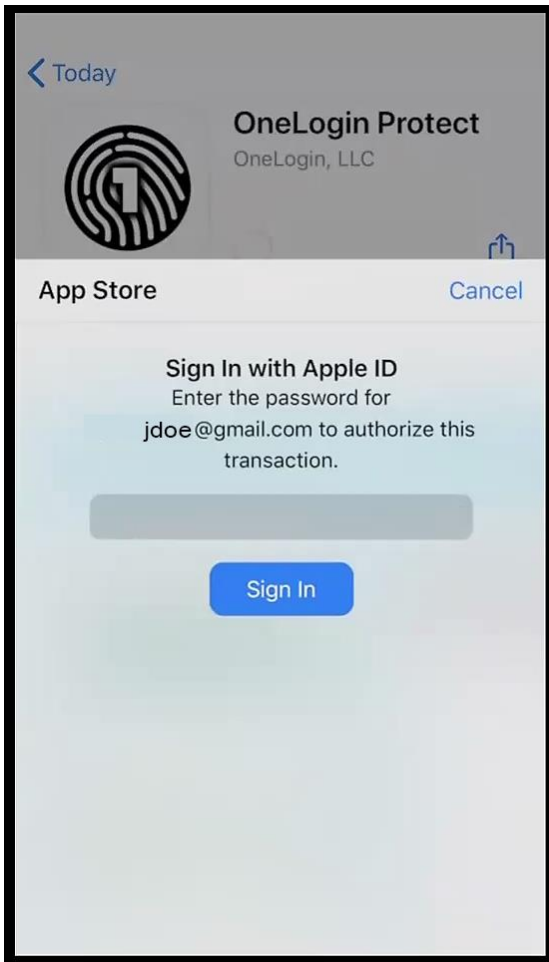
1. Open the App store.



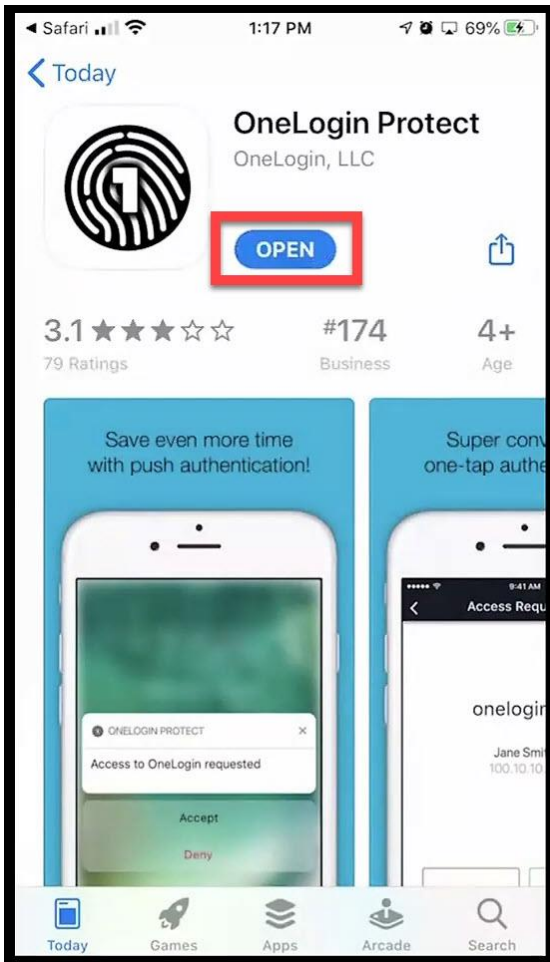
2. At the App store, at the bottom, click to Search for OneLogin Protect and select it.
3. Click Get to download and install the OneLogin Protect App.



4. You may be prompted by the App store to Sign in using your Apple ID.



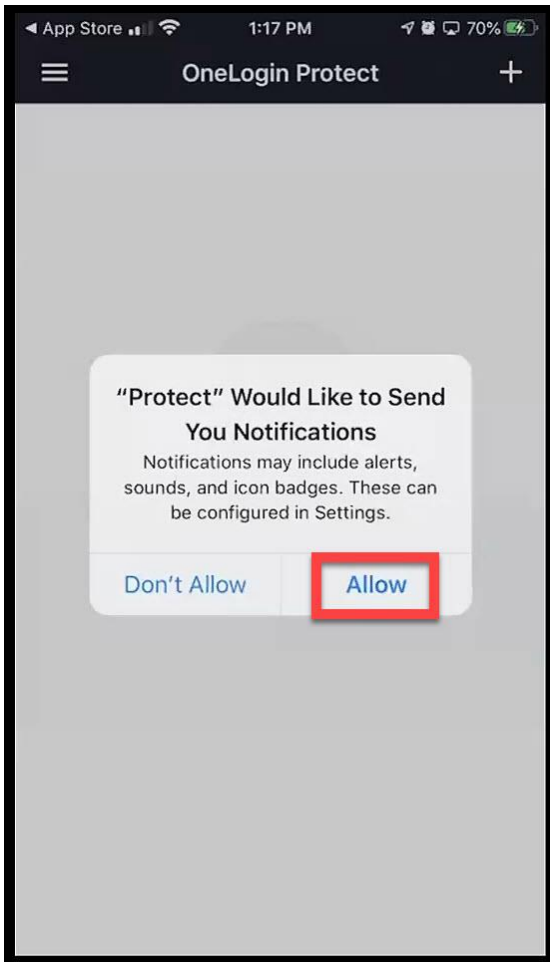
5. Once the App downloads and installs, click Open to open the OneLogin Protect app.



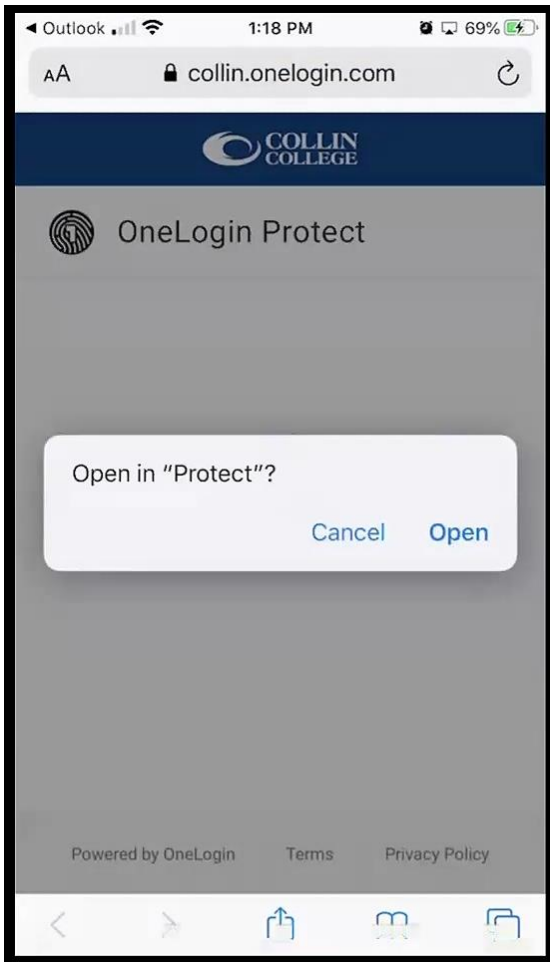
6. The OneLogin Protect will open.



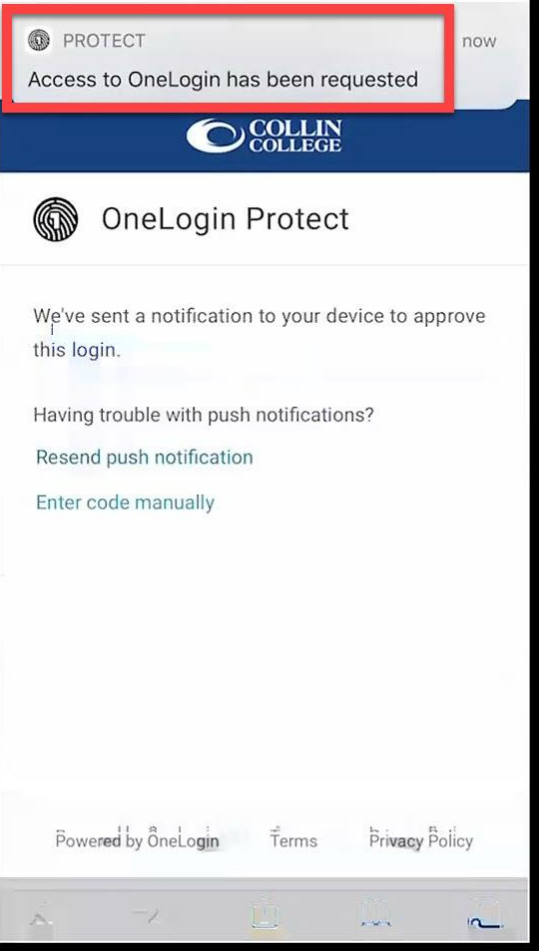
7. You will get a message that the Protect App would like to send you notifications. Click Allow.



8. You will get a message to Open in Protect. Click Open.




9. Here's the phone message where OneLogin Protect is requesting for access. Click Accept.

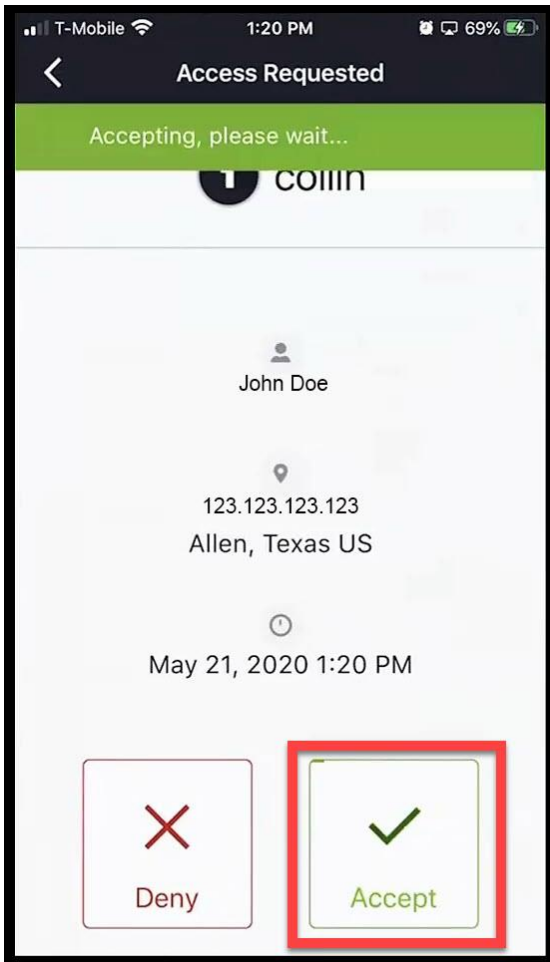

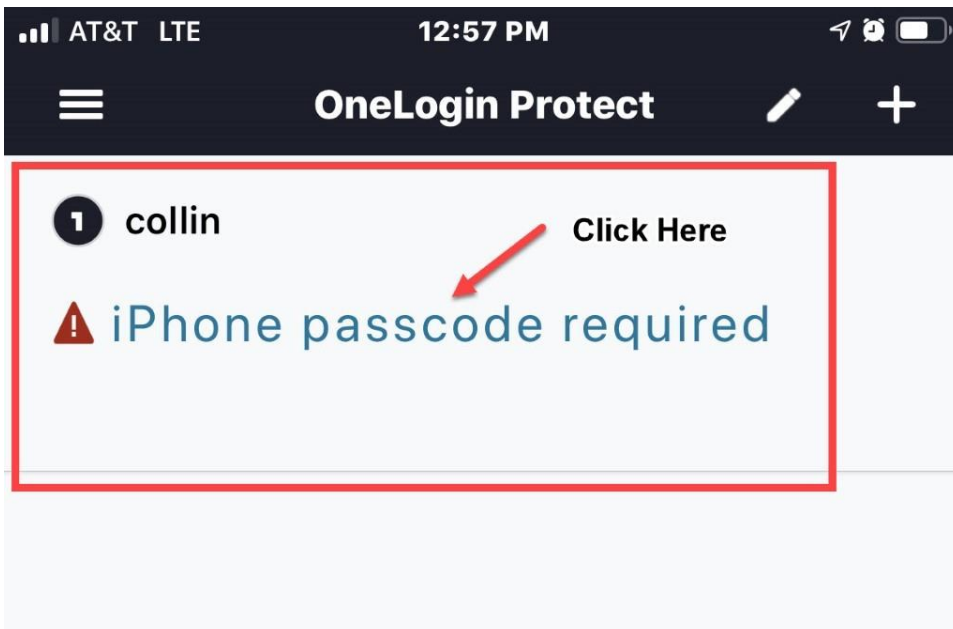

10. OneLogin requires a lock code or Passcode enabled on your phone. If you see the message below in OneLogin, you will need to enable the lockcode on your phone in Settings.



11. Clicking the link will take you to OneLogin Protect Settings but you need to go to your phone Settings



12. In Settings, go to the Lock code/Passcode option.



13. Turn your Passcode On, you will be prompted to set a code.
