About Collin College's Program

The Music Field of Study (FOS) provides approved courses for music majors who intend to transfer to a college or university and further their musical studies. Upon completion of the FOS curriculum, a certificate is awarded to acknowledge readiness to transition to a baccalaureate level at any Texas public institution. An Associate of Arts degree with a Music FOS includes 31 hours of music coursework and 29 credit hours in General Education core. The college is also home to several ensembles and musical groups, allowing students to explore their abilities and perform in respected Collin College venues.
