Where do Licensed Vocational Nurses work?

Licensed Vocational Nurses work in a variety of health care settings including acute care hospitals, skilled nursing facilities (nursing homes), assisted-living facilities, long-term acute care (LTAC) hospitals, memory units, rehabilitation hospitals, schools, clinics, adult and child daycare centers, correctional facilities, psychiatric and substance abuse facilities, dialysis centers, doctors' offices/surgery centers, insurance companies, hospice, and home health care facilities.
