Course Title: Montessori Workshop

Course Description: This workshop is designed to assist early childhood educators and administrators to educate the whole child. Participants will learn to recognize the child as an individual with intellectual, physical and social needs that must be met. During these workshops the participants will learn and participate in Montessori experiences throughout the curriculum areas.

Suggested Course Prerequisite(s): Student must have high school diploma and be able to write and speak English fluently.

Student Learning Outcomes:

- 1) Participants will recognize that children learn through all their senses.
- 2) The participants will learn to use concrete materials to teach abstract concepts.
- 3) Participants will improve their knowledge and skills to practice the Montessori Method of education in an environment with children ages 3 to 6 years.
- 4) Participants will be versed in the initial presentations as well as the variations used through the various areas of the Montessori curriculum.
