

## Course Syllabus

### Course Title: Italian II

#### Course Description:

Intensive Italian conversation, vocabulary and interaction opportunities are provided for students.

#### Suggested Course Prerequisite(s): Italian I

#### Materials Needed: Textbook

#### Course Objectives:

1. Speak Italian using new vocabulary, syntactical exercises which further increase vocabulary and exercises on grammatical structure for business and industry-related settings.
2. Apply information in the classroom by asking and answering questions of both instructor and fellow students.
3. Students will participate orally in class.
4. Demonstrate listening and writing skills by taking dictation in Italian.
5. Reinforce reading skills through the reading of material in the textbook.

#### Lesson Plan – by week or session

- Session 1: Introductions and syllabus. Student and teacher expectations; Capitolo preliminare; Discussion of the alphabet; Introductory lesson on pronunciation, vowel, and consonant sounds
- Session 2: Chapter 1 dialogue, Punti di Vista domande, vocabulary, and grammar; Genders, articles, interrogative expressions; Review homework
- Session 3: Test 1; Chapter 2: Punti di Vista; Adjectives buono/bello exercises; Verb avere/numbers; Homework
- Session 4: Ripasso generale; Textbook assignments; Ripetizione; Pagina culturale
- Session 5: Chapter 3 dialogue, punti di vista domande, vocabulary, and grammar; Regular verbs, prepositions, idiomatic phrases with avere
- Session 6: Ripasso generale; Chapter 3 continuation; Pagina culturale; Homework
- Session 7: Test II; Chapter 4 dialogue, punti di vista domande, vocabulary, and grammar; Studio di parole
- Session 8: Ripasso generale; Ripetizione exercises; Regular verbs ere/ire; Partitives
- Session 9: Chapter 4 continuation; Molto, tanto, troppo, poco, tutto, ogni; Adverbial prepositions
- Session 10: Ripasso generale; Class exercises; Student evaluation of instructor and class

**Course Sessions:** listed are a guideline to indicate all topics that will be covered during your course. Do not plan your personal calendar based on these sessions. Your instructor will give you a calendar for your class that will indicate specific topics, assignments, and days.

**Method of Evaluation:** Unless otherwise stated, course completion is evaluated on the basis of attendance. Students must be in attendance 90% of the class time in order to be considered a successful completer of the course.

Students must be in attendance 90% of each course in a certificate series for successful completion and to earn a certificate as specified.

Students must complete all courses (core and no. of elective courses needed) to complete a certificate series within two years from start date of the first course taken.
