Dictionary form of verbs plus "koto ga dekiru" to express possibility or capability.

Ta-form of verbs to express "to have experienced something."
Ta-form of verbs to express "two or more actions to be done alternately or repeatedly."

Ku-form of adjectives plus "naru" or adjectival nouns plus the particle "ni" plus "naru" to express "to become a certain state."
Te-form of verbs plus "kara" to express "after~ing, "inai".

Ta-form or nai-form of verbs plus "hoo ga ii" to express speaker's suggestions.
