Course Title: Korean I

Course Description: This beginner course teaches students Hangeul (Korean alphabet), basic phonetic rules, vocabulary, grammar, and simple conversations.

Suggested Course Prerequisite(s): None

Course Resources: Textbook (required): Sejong Korean 1A: English Edition; Kong & Park, 9781635190434

Student Learning Outcomes: Demonstrate the use of basic Korean language and engage in simple conversations about daily activities. Learn essential everyday phrases for greetings and introducing yourself, asking and answering questions, countries and jobs, Sino-Korean numbers, things, and basic verbs.

Course Sessions: Listed are guidelines to indicate all topics that will be covered during your course. Do not plan your personal calendar based on these sessions. Your instructor will give you a calendar for your class that will indicate specific topics, assignments, and days.

Lesson Plan: by week or session

Sessions 1, 2, 3, 4: Let's Learn Korean (Vowels and Consonants of Hangeul, Hangeul Practice, Greetings in Korean, Korean Expressions Used in the Classroom)

Sessions 5, 6, 7, 8: Introducing Yourself (Hi, I am Anna, Can I have your phone number?)

Sessions 9, 10, 11, 12: Objects and Movement (My bag is next to the desk, I am studying Korean)
