**Lesson Plan – by week or session:**

**Week 1:** General Overview of Lightroom functionality. A catch-up of everything learned in Adobe Lightroom Basics, with additional information included.

**Week 2:** Basic Panel - Hand editing images to enhance or fix issues.

**Week 3:** Local Adjustments - Brushes, Radial Filters, Graduated Filters.

**Week 4:** Develop Module - Focus on Tone Curve, HSL, Lens Corrections, Transform.

**Week 5:** Slideshows and Print Module, and continuing editing of images

**Course Sessions:** Listed are guidelines to indicate all topics that will be covered during your course. Do not plan your personal calendar based on these sessions. Your instructor will give you a calendar for your class that will indicate specific topics, assignments, and days.

**Method of Evaluation:** Unless otherwise stated, course completion is evaluated on the basis of attendance.
