Course Title: Introduction to Digital Drawing

Course Description:

Learn to create your own stunning digital art! Introduction to Digital Drawing will guide you from starting a new project in the Procreate app to sharing your new work with a unique timelapse video. Using an Ipad and Procreate has become the professional standard for many artists and you can learn these skills in just 6 classes. This class is perfect for anyone who wants to draw on their Ipad but doesn't know where to start!

Suggested Course Prerequisite(s):

Basic skills with using an Apple iPad tablet. Ability to speak and understand English.

Students will bring their personal iPad tablets for use in class with the Procreate app installed. Purchase of the Procreate app is required: \$9.99 in the app store, a one-time fee. Compatible electronic stylus is recommended, but not required.

Lesson Plan – by session:

Session 1: Introduction to Procreate – basic tool and canvas setup overview: layers, select, move, etc.

Session 2: Layers in depth -- organization, multiple blending mode interactions, grouping, clipping masks, reference, etc.

Session 3: Procreate and Art Theory --color theory, texture and depth, focus, value, creating depth with layers and blending modes.

Session 4: Professional Procreate -- text, product overlays, doodle gridding, construction and architecture uses.

Session 5: Special Effects and Social Media -- symmetry, Magic Wand, animation, video export, vectors, creating your own brushes.

Session 6: Tying it all together -- we will do an advanced painting during class using all the techniques covered. You'll get to cement all the new skills you've learned and ask any questions you may still have. You'll finish the class with a piece of beautiful art.
