

How to Apply for the Cybersecurity Program

Step 1:

Log onto apply.collin.edu and select 'Create a New Account' if you have never applied to Collin College before. If you have applied to Collin College, please provide the email address you used previously and the password you had created. Forgot password in an option if needed.



You will then complete pages 4-11 which will ask you for your educational history, residency information, professional career history, and other educational background information. You will be required to send official transcripts from every college you have attended in the US. If you have not attended a college, you will be required to send an official high school transcript.

To send official electronic copies of your transcripts, have them sent to Transcripts@collin.edu.

At the end of the application, be sure to 'Submit' the application; otherwise, the document will not be processed. Applications take 2-3 business days to be processed by the Admissions and Records Departments. Once processed, you will receive an email with your username and password for Cougarweb (your student portal) and a list of documents you will need to provide to the college.

Once you have a Cougarweb login credentials and have requested that your transcript be sent to Transcripts@collin.edu, you need to request an evaluation.

Log into your [CougarWeb](#) account and under the Home Tab select REQUEST TRANSFER CREDIT EVALUATION. Students will receive notification via their Collin email account when it has been completed. After the transfer credit evaluation (also applies to current/former Collin students) you will be contacted regarding next steps for the BAT admissions process.
