#### **Dance Improvisation**

Interested in learning how to discover your own movement style? Do you want to learn how to make choices in relationship to your environment and other dancers? Enroll in Dance Improvisation 1101 and jump start your own ideas about movement. This class is designed to help students develop creative potential, personal movement style, and expressiveness. This class is well-suited for all dance students from all dance backgrounds and with varied levels of dance experience.

#### **Dance Composition**

Interested in developing your own movement ideas and creative voice? Do you want to delve into movement by composing your own dance phrases? Continue the formal process of generating movement by enrolling in Dance Composition 1201 (prerequisite Dance Improvisation 1101). This class is designed to develop the necessary skills for creating, composing, and realizing movement ideas and themes so that you can create a world through movement. This class is well-suited to dance majors and dance students interested in a deeper study of choreography.
