## CNA Course Details:

- CNA classes are held on both the Collin College Technical Campus and the Wylie Campus.
- The CNA lecture, lab and clinical rotations are scheduled from 3-7 p.m. (CTC) or 5-9 p.m. (WC) in the spring and fall semester and from 8 a.m. – 12 p.m. in the summer semester.
- There are two program options:
  - An accelerated 7-week program that meets four days a week (Monday-Thursday)
  - A 14-week program that

## What will I learn?

### **NURA 1301 Nurse Aide for Health Care (3 Credit Hours)**

- Knowledge, skills and abilities essential to provide basic care to residents of long-term care facilities.
- Resident's rights, communication, safety, observation, reporting and assisting residents in maintaining basic comfort and safety.
- Emphasis is on effective interaction with members of the health care team, restorative services, mental health and social service needs.

### **NURA 1160 Clinical – Nursing Aide (1 Credit Hour)**

- A health-related work-based learning experience that enables the student to apply specialized occupational theory, skills and concepts.
- Direct supervision is provided by the clinical instructor.
- Prerequisite: NURA 1301 or consent of Program Director.
- NOTE: All students are required to provide their own reliable transportation to and from clinical rotation sites.



## Where can I work and how much will I make?

CNA's can work at nursing homes, home health agencies, long-term care facilities and some hospital settings.
