ROLES: All roles are open. We seek diversity in casting, including all ethnicities, ages, and genders – all will be considered for all roles. Audition for the role you want! [**PLEASE NOTE:** This is a non-paying show. Roles are open to current students, alumni, and community.]

Seymour Krelborn: A menial laborer at Mushnik's Flower Shop, and the improbable hero of the story. Nebbish-like and insecure, he is naive and feels much put-upon. In spite of his flaws, he's a sweet and well-meaning little man - and is the owner of the carnivorous plant, Audrey II. **Vocal range: C3-A2 (tenor)**

Audrey: The gum-snapping, secret love of Seymour's life who works with him at the flower shop. **Lacking** in education and self-esteem, she suffers from feelings of hopelessness at her situation in life, including her abusive relationship with her boyfriend, Orin Scrivello. **Vocal range: G#3-G#5 (mezzo)**

Mr. Mushnik: Owner of Mushnik's Flower Shop, a failing business on Skid Row. Given to cursing in Yiddish, he is a man who seldom smiles and often yells. **Vocal range: G2-F4 (baritone)**

Orin Scrivello: Audrey's dentist boyfriend, a motorcycle-riding black leather jacket-wearing tough-guy. He is tall, dark, handsome, and sadistic. Vocal range: G4-G2 (bass w/ upper extension or baritone w/ lower extension)

Audrey II: A wise-cracking anthropomorphic cross between a Venus flytrap and an avocado with teeth. It is Seymour's favorite and soon-famous plant, which he purchased during a mysterious total eclipse of the sun - but once the plant has the taste of human blood there is no stopping it. **Vocal range: G2-G#4** (bass w/ upper extension or baritone w/ lower extension)

Crystal, Ronette, and Chiffon: Three female street urchins who function as participants in the action and as "doo-wop" chorus girls outside it, they often sing directly to the audience in a hip, narrative style. **Vocal range: Ab3-G5 (mezzo)**

Patrick Martin: A sleazy opportunist who tries to talk Seymour and Mr. Mushnik into leaf cuttings of Audrey II. **Vocal range: C3-F2 (baritone** <u>or </u>**tenor)**

Wino #1, Wino #2, Wino #3: Always hanging around, sometimes singing. Vocal range: treble or tenor/bass (A-F respectively)

Bernstein: An uptown bigshot from NBC, who offers Seymour his own gardening show. **Vocal range: B4-A5** (soprano) or C3-G#2 (tenor)

Mrs. Luce: The wife of the editor of Life magazine. Vocal range: C3-C6 (high soprano)
