

Fire Officer III (Online)

Fire Officer III is a midlevel supervisor who performs both supervisory and first-line managerial functions and has met all the job performance and certification requirements of Fire Officer II as defined in NFPA 1021, Standard for Fire Officer Professional Qualifications. Upon completion of this course, students will take the state certification exam for Fire Officer III.
