

Fire Officer I (Online)

FIRT 1442 - Focuses on the skills necessary for effective supervision and leadership at the Company Officer level. Students may enroll as CE or earn 4 semester credit hours, applicable towards an AAS degree in Fire Science. Upon completion of this course, students will take the state certification exam for Fire Officer.
