

Fire Officer II (Online)

FIRT 1443 - Focuses on the skills necessary for effective supervision and management at the Company Officer II level. Students may enroll as CE or earn 4 semester credit hours applicable towards an AAS degree in Fire Science. Upon completion of this course, students will take the state certification exam for Fire Officer II.

Requirements: Students must hold Fire Officer I Certification.
