An Incident Safety Officer is an individual who has met the requirements of Fire Officer Level I specified in NFPA 1021, Standard for Fire Officer Professional Qualifications and Chapter 5 of NFPA 1521, Standard for Fire Department Safety Officer.

Requirements: Basic Structural Fire Protection, Aircraft Rescue Fire Fighting, or Marine Fire Protection certification; and Fire Officer 1 certification.
