





Rope Rescue Awareness & Operations

This 40-hour course is designed to meet the NFPA 1670 - Standard on Operations and Training for Technical Search and Rescue Incidents for awareness and operations levels of technical rope rescue, and NFPA 1006 - Standard for Technical Rescue Personnel Professional Qualifications Scope. Training will include essential skills and techniques required to perform basic rope rescue operations safely. The course includes both classroom and field instruction.
