Procedures

The District President or designee will develop procedures addressing protections and accommodations, consistent with law, for students who are pregnant (and experiencing absences due to pregnancy, childbirth, or resulting medical conditions) or parenting, including procedures for early registration or pre-registration and leaves of absence.

Liaison for Pregnant and Parenting Students

The District President or designee will designate a pregnant and parenting students liaison for current and incoming students. Under this policy, parenting students are those who are the parents or legal guardians of children under 18 years of age.

The designated pregnant and parenting students liaison's name and contact information will be posted on the College District's website. The liaison will provide information on and access to resources for pregnant and parenting students designed to help them successfully and timely complete a degree or certificate. The liaison will also serve as the point of contact for a student requesting a legal protection or reasonable accommodation under Education Code 51.982.

Publication of Information

The procedures and the liaison's name and contact information will be published in the student handbooks and posted on the College District's website in a manner that is readily available to current and incoming students who are the parents or guardians of children under 18 years old.
