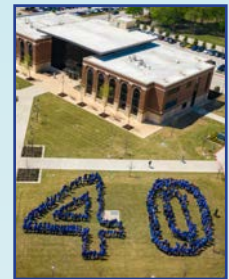

## 1. Collin College Celebrates Four Decades of Student Success

- Festivities kicked off with a **celebratory concert** on April 4 featuring Texas Country music legend **Pat Green** alongside his acoustic quartet and **The Jared Stout Band**. The students-, employee-, and alumni-only event brought exciting entertainment to the Plano Campus where music, food trucks, and Collin College pride filled the evening.
- As a tribute to Collin College's original campus, the **Where It All Began Music Festival** at the McKinney Campus on April 5 was a fun-packed day with six musical acts performing in a variety of styles. Collin College's Celina Campus also celebrated the district's 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary with its annual **Celina Campus Carnival**. The free event welcomed more than 1,100 visitors to the Celina Campus on April 9.

## 2. Collin College to Offer New Bachelor's Degree in Software Development Starting Fall 2025

- Collin College will offer a new **Bachelor of Applied Technology (BAT)** in Software Development starting Fall 2025, launching the college's **fifth** baccalaureate degree.
- Thanks to the hard work and commitment of **Dr. Jon Hardesty**, vice president of academic affairs, and his team, the college received final approval for the degree from the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges on April 4.
- The program, which will be offered at **Collin College's Frisco Campus**, builds upon the college's current Associate of Applied Science degree in Software Development.

## 3. Collin College Designated as "Military Friendly" for 10<sup>th</sup> Consecutive Year

- Collin College has been named a **2025-26 Military Friendly® School**, as well as a **Military Spouse Friendly School**. This is the **10<sup>th</sup> consecutive year** the college has been recognized with a Military Friendly designation.

- Institutions which earn Military Friendly® School designations have been evaluated using both public data sources and responses from a proprietary survey which measure factors including student retention, graduation, job placement, loan repayment, persistence (degree advancement or transfer), and loan default rates for all students and, specifically, for student veterans.
- **More than 1,800 schools** participated in the **2025-26 survey** with **830** earning special awards for going above the standard. Collin College was awarded the silver designation in the Large Community Colleges category.

### 4. Technical Campus Hosts Annual Open House and Car Meet

- The fifth annual **Collin College Technical Campus Open House** welcomed about 900 people on April 12.
- The half-day event **highlighted academic programs** available at the campus through interactive demonstrations including advanced robotics, virtual reality simulations, and more.
- In addition to the open house, the highly anticipated **car meet** showcased a revolving line-up of custom, classic, exotic, and muscle cars.



### 5. Collin College's Law Enforcement Academy Integrates Motorola Body Cameras in Training

- The Collin College Law Enforcement Academy has integrated the use of **Motorola V700 body cameras** into its curriculum, elevating its police training.
- This critical technology promotes **transparency, policing accountability, and public trust**, all critical elements for cadets in their future careers.
- The cameras, a donation from **Motorola Solutions**, are a useful tool for instructors and students to analyze performance, identify areas of improvement, and provide real-life scenarios to shape future law enforcement officers.

### 6. Texas Workforce Commission Presents Collin College with Skills Development Fund Grants

- Check presentations totaling **\$1.3 million** in Skills Development Fund grants were held April 9 at the Collin College Higher Education Center.
- The grants, which are provided by the Texas Workforce Commission, were spread across **13 local Collin County businesses** and will support the training of 130 new employees and upgrade the skills of 714 currently employed workers.
- Collin College's grants department works with each business to secure the grants and will arrange the needed skills-improvement training.
- Training offerings vary and focus on **upgrading skills** in manufacturing, finances, information technology, and more.
