Collin College's Strategies of Behavioral Intervention (SOBI) Committee is an interdisciplinary, district-wide team whose mission is to respond to distressed and threatening behavior in order to thwart and redirect behavior that might otherwise undermine instruction and negatively impact student learning. In order to accomplish this, the SOBI team has designed a process for assisting students who may display various levels of concerning behavior (e.g., strange or unusual behavior; changes in dress, personal hygiene, or physical appearance; threats of harm to self or others; etc.). Any behavior that becomes a concern to you or that negatively affects your ability to succeed as a student at Collin College may be referred to SOBI. Please note that SOBI is not a disciplinary committee, and SOBI actions are not a substitute for Collin College's student disciplinary process. If SOBI determines there has been an alleged violation(s) of the [*Student Code of Conduct*](#), the referral will be submitted to the Dean of Students Office for disciplinary action.
