Religious Holy Days

In accordance with <u>Section 51.911</u> of the <u>Texas Education Code</u> and Collin College Board policy <u>FC (LEGAL)</u>, Collin College will excuse a student from attending classes or other required activities, including examinations, for the observance of a religious holy day. A student whose absence is excused under this provision may not be penalized for that absence and will be allowed to take an examination or complete an assignment within a reasonable time after the absence. Students are required to file a written request with each professor prior to the census date of the course to qualify for an excused absence. A copy of the state rules and procedures regarding holy days is available from the Registrar's Office.
