

Religious Holy Days

In accordance with [Section 51.911](#) of the [Texas Education Code](#) and Collin College Board policy [FC \(LEGAL\)](#), Collin College will excuse a student from attending classes or other required activities, including examinations, for the observance of a religious holy day. A student whose absence is excused under this provision may not be penalized for that absence and will be allowed to take an examination or complete an assignment within a reasonable time after the absence. Students are required to file a written request with each professor prior to the census date of the course to qualify for an excused absence. A copy of the state rules and procedures regarding holy days is available from the Registrar's Office.
