

## **Class Notes**

Note taking assistance takes different forms within a specific course depending upon the needs of the student as well as the faculty learning objectives and teaching style.

The student is required to discuss this accommodation with their professor(s).

Note taking assistance may include copies of faculty notes, other displayed materials used in class, and power point slides.

It also includes the use of approved note taking devices, audio recording, and other assistive technology devices.

Approved note taking devices include smart pens, computers, tablets and cell phones, or other devices.

Any peer note taking is done on a voluntary basis. You may be asked to assist in finding a peer note taker.

If a student misses class, there is no obligation to provide notes or recording for the missed class.

The student has completed the Class Notes Agreement verifying that they will not share any materials and will use them only for personal educational purposes.
