Less Distracted Area for Testing (Testing Center)

This accommodation allows the student to take exams, tests, and quizzes in a place with limited noise and distraction. The student has completed the Alternative Testing Agreement verifying that they will follow Testing procedures. Students are required to plan with their instructor for these accommodations, including how instructors wish to be reminded about placing tests in the Testing Center (i.e., by email, in person, a week in advance, one class period in advance, etc.) and when the tests open and close.

*<u>DUAL CREDIT STUDENTS</u>: Only students taking courses at a Collin College campus can use the ACCESS Office or Collin College Testing Center for testing accommodations.

Students who take their courses at their high school campus will use their high school campus testing resources. Most high schools have a designated room for testing accommodations. If a student needs help making testing arrangements at their high school, they should contact the high school campus 504 coordinator or their high school counselor.
