1	Author,	Is there one author: <i>Last name, First name</i> Is there two authors: <i>Last name, First name, First name Last name</i> Is there three authors: <i>Last name, First name, et al.</i>
2	Title of source,	If this source is in a container such as a book or journal: <i>"Title."</i> If not: <i>Title</i>

3	Title of container,	If the source is inside a container, such as a book or journal: <i>Title of Container,</i>
4	Other contributors,	If the container has additional contributors, such as an <i>editor, illustrator, director, or translator: role First name Last name,</i>
5	Version,	If the container is a particular version or edition, put that information here as it was listed by the book. For example, fourth edition, annotated edition, new expanded version.
6	Number,	If the container is one in a series or collection: <i>no. #</i> If the container is a journal: <i>vol. #, no. #</i> Ordinal numbers are written in Arabic numerals (1 st , not first)
7	Publisher,	If the container has a publisher, list it here. Publishers are not required for periodicals.
8	Publication date,	The publication date of the source should go here. If there is more than one date, the most meaningful or relevant date should go here.
9	Location,	If the source is in a container: <i>p. or pp. followed by the page number</i> If the source is online and there is no DOI: <i>URL</i> If the source is online and there is a DOI: <i>doi: followed by the doi number</i>
